As you are aware, parent workshops, events and meetings have not been held in school during the course of the pandemic. This has helped us to minimise the risk of Covid19 and its impact upon our school, staff and families.

Parents have requested to be able to return into school, therefore we will begin some parent workshops and events again in the Spring term. This will of course be dependent on the local and national picture regarding Covid19 as well as any government guidance that schools receive.
