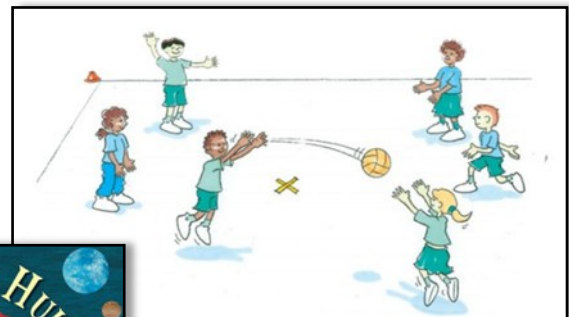

What will we be learning about this half term

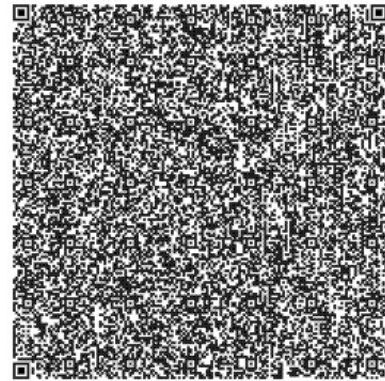
