

What will we be learning about this half term

This half term we are learning about the element texture.

What you could do at home

Discuss and ask the children questions such as:

- What is the Platinum Jubilee celebrating?
- Why is this a significant achievement?
- What is a Jubilee?
- How do people celebrate it?

Explore images of the queen throughout the 70 years but with a specific focus on your given decade – 1990-2000. Ask the children about what significant things happened in her life in this decade? Look at portraits of the Queen from this decade. Are there any similarities between them? How is she portrayed?











What will we be learning about this half term

This half term, the children will be learning how to make music. They will be selecting and creating a range of media including text, images, sounds and video. They will learn to understand the activities involved in planning, creating and evaluating computing artefacts.

What you could do at home

Explore different types of music, including the pitch and tempo.

Download the app children have been using to create music and plan, create and evaluate music.

To recognise note lengths and common percussion instruments.

Writing

What will we be learning about this half term

We will be using a range of descriptive vocabulary to:

- Write a narrative in the form of a fairy tale/traditional tale
 - Write a non-chronological report

What you could do at home

Generate interesting adjectives with children by playing 'guess who'. You could use members of your family, celebrities or use clipart images of people. You must each describe a person and the other player will try to guess who it is based on the adjectives used. E.g. "She has curly, long hair"

Read regularly with your child at home so they are exposed to a variety of story types and vocabulary.

Encourage writing as much as possible. If you go to the park on the weekend, could children write a diary entry about their experience? Can they write a story about their favourite toy?











Geography

What will we be learning about this half term

This half term, children will be understanding how to use a compass and use directional language. Children will use photographs, sketches and maps to describe the human and physical geography of the local area. Children will learn to understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the UK, and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country.

Children to understand compass directions/locational and directional language.

Mathematics

What will we be learning about this half term

This half term children will be learning to Identify, and partition numbers using different representations to at least 100. Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems. Solve problems involving multiplication and division, using different strategies.

What you could do at home

Encourage your child to complete the set Maths homework.

Allow them opportunities to add and subtract two-digit numbers. Get them to explain their thought process and discuss how they would solve simple word problems.

What will we be learning about this half term

This half term we will be completing the recorders course. Students will be learning the notes on a recorder to help them compose a piece of music. They will also be learning how to improvise and create their own music using their recorders.

Physical Education

What will we be learning about this half term

In this unit, pupils will be introduced to the basic skills required in Net and Wall games. Pupils will learn the importance of the ready position. They will develop throwing, catching and racket skills, learning to track and hit a ball. They will learn to play against an opponent and over a net. They will begin to use rules and simple tactics when playing against a partner. They will be encouraged to demonstrate good sportsmanship and show respect towards others.

Encourage children to explore and develop agility, balance, co-ordination, speed, and stamina by taking part in outdoor activities such as football, rugby, badminton, tennis which includes the involvement of nets.

What will we be learning about this half term

This half term, we will be focusing on what can help us grow and stay healthy.

How different things help our bodies to be healthy, including food and drink, physical activity, sleep and rest.

How eating and drinking too much sugar can affect our health, including dental health.
