

What will we be learning about this half term

What you could do at home

One simple and enjoyable way is through allowing the children to help in the kitchen safely. Speak to your children about measurements such as cup, tsp, and tbsp.

What will we be learning about this half term

This term in computing, our focus is on understanding how to use algorithms to create digital music and programme quizzes. Children will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

We will be looking closely at how a computer can create a musical pattern and further discussing how that music makes us feel.

This half term, the children will be introduced to non-chronological reports and will be given chance to use their writing skills to produce a report on nocturnal animals. Also, children will be using the skills they have acquired throughout the year to write a diary entry.

What you could do at home

Read regularly with your child at home so they are exposed to a variety of diaries and non-chronological reports.

Encourage writing as much as possible. Can they research about nocturnal animals and the various types?

Encourage reading and ask children to orally create their own ending.













What will we be learning about this half term:

We will be learning about different measurements of mass, capacity and temperature. Children will be using appropriate units of measurement and they will be estimating, measuring and making comparisons of different measurements. Finally, we will be moving onto money.

What will we be learning about this half term

This half term we will be focusing on striking and fielding. During this unit children will develop their skills with underarm throwing and catching when fielding. They will develop their striking skills for distance and accuracy. Children will develop decision making to get a batter out, whilst under pressure.



Explore different character emotions in books and discuss how certain situations can be resolved.
