## Year 1M parents

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are following advice from Public Health England to ensure that we are taking the right actions to keep our school family in good health. They have advised that children and staff in **1M** need to self-isolate for 14 days from the last known contact with a positive case. This means your child will need to self-isolate until 21<sup>st</sup> December. We look forward to welcoming your children back to school on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021**. The advice from Public Health England is that children will only need to be tested if they develop any of the symptoms as listed on the DfE and NHS websites:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child is entitled to a free school meal, we are able to provide a packed lunch for them throughout the period of their self-isolation. You will be able to collect them from outside the main office entrance between 12:15 and 12:30.

The class teacher will be providing video lessons and work through Microsoft TEAMS. Please log onto Microsoft TEAMS using the log on details that were previously sent to you. If you need any support with this please email your class teacher.

We will also prepare a work pack for any children that cannot access the online work. This will be ready to collect from outside the main office entrance between 12.15 and 12.30 today (Friday)
