Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sure you will have heard by now that our Prime Minister has announced a further national lockdown. Unlike the second lockdown we experienced in November, this one does affect school.

As a result of the announcement, Prince Albert will now be closed to all pupils except for pupils of critical workers and vulnerable pupils.

Government guidance states that if you CAN keep your pupil at home then you should do so. This provision is only available if you do not have anyone to look after your child at home.


The majority of pupils will now begin the process of learning from home. We will be using the Microsoft Teams platform for this and daily work will be set by your child's class teacher. Where children are not engaging, phone calls home will be made as part of our safeguarding duty to all our pupils.
