## **World Cup**

I am writing to inform you that we will be taking part in a range of activities to promote the World Cup from the week beginning 20<sup>th of</sup> November 2022. During our launch assemblies, each class will be choosing a country that is taking part in the World Cup and we would like children to work on a home-based project based on their country. As soon as a country has been chosen, children will bring a slip home to let you know their chosen country. Examples of these projects may be making monuments out of resources (cardboard etc) or creating a fact-file based on research. Other examples may include drawing or painting landmarks or famous events. Children may even opt to create a dish from that country. This project should last over 4-5 weeks whilst the World Cup is still going on. At the end of the World Cup, children who have created the best projects will receive a prize. Please can children bring their projects in on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2022.

Children will also be involved in lunchtime-based sports where they will earn points and win a prize for their class. Food from different countries will also be served at lunchtimes. Children will get the opportunity to dress in the colours of their designated countries on the last Friday before the World Cup ends (Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2022) as this will create a colourful and vibrant atmosphere in school to help celebrate this event.
