**RE: Union Action** 

Dear Parents/Carers,

You may be aware from media coverage that the teaching union, NEU (teachers), has declared strike action which will take place on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023. The strike is happening as the NEU is in dispute with the Secretary of State for Education because he has failed to make available additional and sufficient funds to allow employers to pay a fully funded increase in teachers' pay at a rate greater than inflation. This is a national dispute between the unions and the government, and not because of any issues at our school.

I am writing to you to give you as much notice as possible that learning may be disrupted on this date. We are considering several options, including providing home learning packs and closing the school. Teachers are under no obligation to inform us of their intent to strike so we may not know until the morning of 15<sup>th</sup>/16<sup>th</sup> March if we need to close your child's class for the day. We recommend that you start to make alternative childcare arrangements for this date.

In the event your child is not able to be at school due to their teacher striking, we will text you on the morning of Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March and the morning of 16<sup>th</sup> March to inform you not to bring them to school. Included in this text will be a link to a form where you can let school know if you require a packed lunch for your child if they are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 or are in receipt of a free school meal. This meal will need to be collected from school and details will follow on the day.

We are sorry about the potential disruption to you and to your child's education. I understand that this situation may be frustrating and ask that all members of our school community continue to treat each other with respect. Prince Albert Community Trust remains committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our pupils and delivering high-quality teaching.

We are working closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation and we will inform you of the final arrangements as soon as possible.
