



Year 6 Residential trip to Kingswood, Norfolk - Friday 5th July - Sunday 7th July 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our enrichment activities and experience of learning outside of the classroom, your child in year 6 is being given the opportunity to visit the Kingswood Centre, Norfolk, from Friday 5^{th} July – Sunday 7^{th} July 2024

The residential is available to all year 6 children, however due to a limited number of spaces we can only guarantee places to the first 30 children to return their <u>non-refundable deposit of £50</u>, payable via the online school money system. **No cash accepted!** *Please be aware that no places will be quaranteed until the deposit has been received.*

At the PACT we encourage as many children to take part as possible and so subsidise the experience heavily to reduce the cost to yourselves, meaning **parents will only have to pay £165** (including the deposit). After the deposit has been paid the rest can be paid in instalments up to the end of April by which time all money needs to have been paid in full. As normal, all payments including the deposit, will be via the online school money system. **No cash accepted!**

The residential trip offers accommodation at The Kingswood Centre, Overstrand where all food provided on site is Halal and vegetarian so will suit the dietary requirements of all our children. Boys and girls have separate dormitories monitored by staff, either male or female, accordingly.

There will be an information meeting with further details on Monday 9th October at 3:45 in the Junior Hall.

This will be a great opportunity for your child to experience aspects of socialising and team building outside of the classroom as well as being their final chance to have a trip away with their friends from their school. It will also prepare your child for secondary school by enabling him/her to become more independent and to broaden his/her knowledge of life, cultural differences and working together with people who they don't know as well. All this building them up to be ready for their next step in life at secondary schools.

Subsequent meetings for all parents of children with a secured place on the residential trip will also be taking place and you will be informed of this in writing. During these meetings full details will be given and there will be plenty of opportunities to ask questions. It is important that you attend these meetings if your child is on the trip.
