Dear Parents and Carers of children in Reception,

RE: Homework

### Homework Folder

This half term, children will bring home phonics homework every week in a purple folder. They will have a sheet to practise each sound that they have learnt in school that week. Please ensure that children practise at home and complete the sheets each week.

**Homework will be issued every Friday and children will be expected to bring their homework folder back every Wednesday.**

Please look after the homework folders as we will not be able to replace any that get lost or damaged.

### Reading

All children will take home a book to read for pleasure from their class library each week.

The children will be expected to read for at least 10 minutes every day and record a comment in their home reading journals weekly.

In a few weeks, children will also bring home a decodable reading book. This book will be fully decodable and consist of sounds which have already been taught and are familiar to the children. Books will be issued every Friday and will need to be returned to school every Thursday.

ALL children will also take home different harder to read and spell words as well as spellings which align to the graphemes taught that week.

### Homework bags

All children will be given a plastic book bag to keep their homework folder and reading books in. Please look after these carefully as we will not be able to replace any lost bags. Children will come home with their plastic homework bag, homework folder and homework grid this week. Reading journals and reading books will be given out as soon as possible next week.
