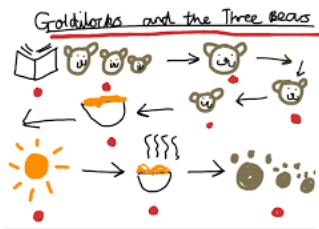

Key skills
<p>Choose your favourite story to read at home. Can you identify the characters in the story? Talk about the characters, what are they called? Can you draw a picture of your favourite character?</p>

Key skills
<p>Continue to share books with your children, do they have a favourite story which is familiar to them?</p> <p>When we read a story, we follow the words from left to right.</p> <p>Can you follow the words in the story using your finger?</p>

W/C: 20/1/25
Key skills
<p>Can you choose your favourite storybook? Then choose one character from the story, how are they feeling? Were they happy, sad, angry, or worried?</p> <p>Talk about why they felt that way. How did the other characters feel?</p>

Key skill: To re-tell a simple story.

Can you read one of your favourite books, or a new book? What happened in the story?

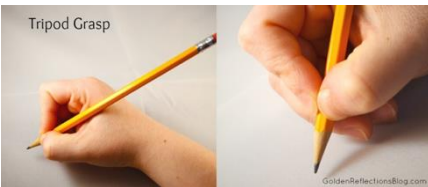
Can you draw what happened in the story?

Key skill: To practise using writing tools.

- Name the features of the book.
- Look at the front cover, what do you think the story is about?
- Look at the pictures inside, name any objects they don't know the name of.
- What is happening in the pictures?
- Read the words to your child.
