WEEK 1

Nature Hunt Adventure

Go on a walk with a grown-up and find 5 natural items, like leaves, sticks, or flowers. Name each item and describe how it feels (e.g., soft, rough, smooth). Draw a picture of your favourite item and say why you like it.

WEEK 2

Weather Watchers

Look out the window every day this week and notice the weather. Use a chart to record whether it's sunny, rainy, windy, or cloudy. Draw a picture of your favorite kind of weather and explain why it's your favourite.

WEEK 3

Bug Spotting

Look for small creatures outside, like ants, ladybirds, or worms. Find and describe 3 bugs—what colour are they? How do they move? Draw your favourite bug and share what you think it might eat or where it might live.

WEEK 4

Tree Friends

Visit a nearby tree and explore it. Feel the bark and describe what it feels like. Look at the leaves—what shapes and patterns can you see? If you find a fallen leaf, bring it home and stick it onto paper to keep as a memory.

Sounds of Nature

Sit quietly outside or by an open window. Listen carefully—what sounds can you hear? Write or draw 3 things you heard (e.g., birds, rustling leaves, cars). Try to copy one of the sounds using your voice or hands.

Growing Wonders

Plant a seed, like cress or sunflower, at home. Draw a picture of the seed. Check on it every day this week and talk about what you see—has anything changed? What do you think plants need to grow?
