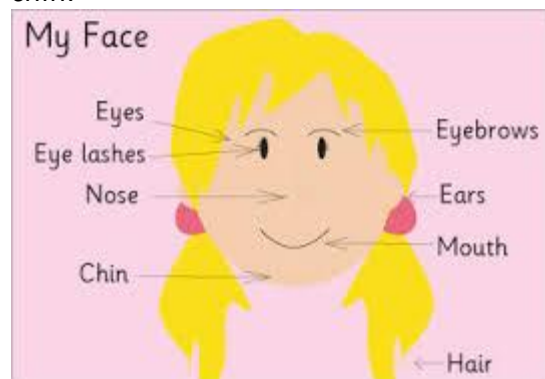
Key skill: To name the features of our face.

Can your child point to their feature when you name one?

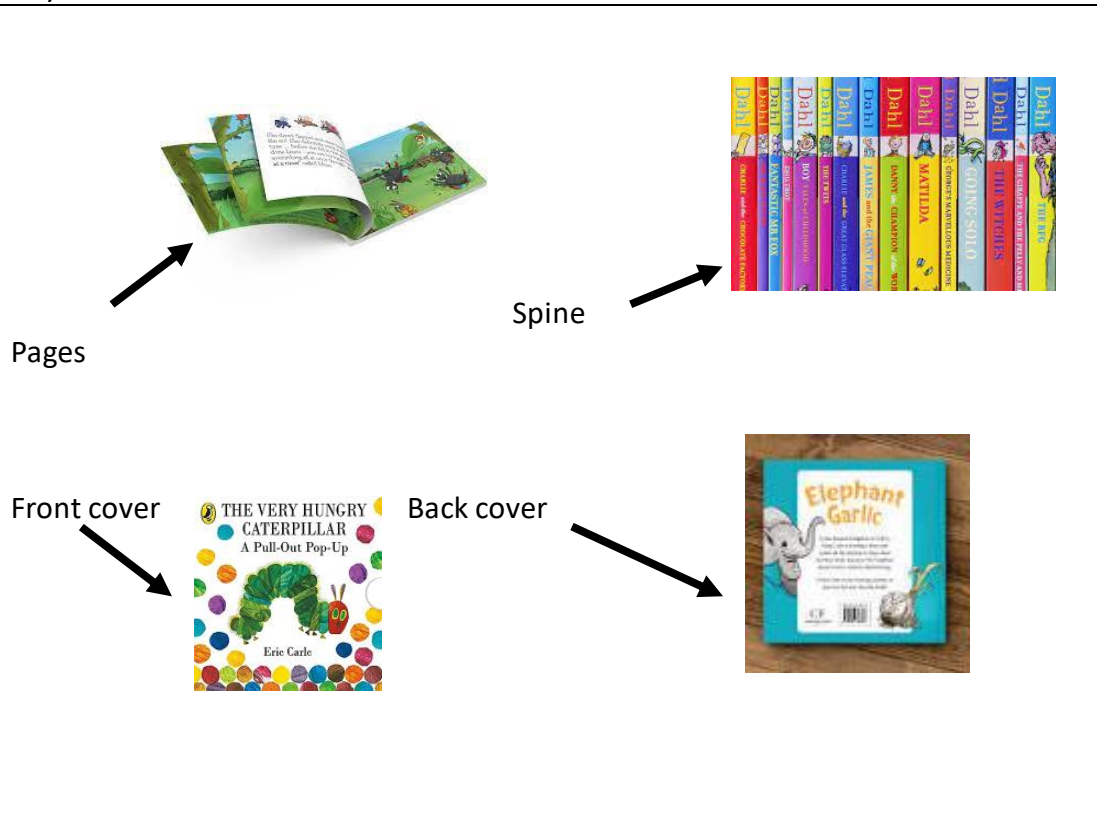
Can your child name the feature of their face you point to?

Key skill: To learn the names of the features of a book.





Using your favourite book can you look at the features, naming them and pointing to them when you find each one.

Key skill: To practise putting on our coats and shoes and taking them off independently.



As we begin to develop our independence skills, it is important we encourage the children to get ready for school. Allow them to practise putting on their shoes and coat. Allow extra time in the morning for this to happen!
