Reading and Phonics

What will we be learning about this half term

This half term, children will be focusing on word reading which involves using a range of decoding strategies to read words. We will be teaching the following graphemes:

/u/ o, /j/ <g>, /j/ <ge>, /j/ <dge> /s/ <st>, /s/ <ce>, <se> /n/ <gn> <kn> /r/ <wr> /m/ <mb> /z/ <se> <ze> /ear/

During our guided reading lesson, children will also be asked simple retrieval questions.
