I hope this letter finds you well. We are writing to inform you about an exciting new initiative to further enhance your child's learning. Starting this half term, we will be introducing home learning designed to support and enrich the curriculum.

Each half term, we will be uploading a project-based task linked to a specific topic onto our school website. For this half term, the focus will be on ***Our Great City, Birmingham***. This theme will provide opportunities for children to explore Birmingham's rich history, culture, landmarks, and community.

In addition to the project, we ask that children dedicate time each week to the following:

- **20 minutes daily on Times Tables Rockstars** to strengthen their fluency in multiplication and division.
- **20 minutes daily on Oxford University Press resources** to build comprehension and vocabulary skills.
- **20 minutes daily on Spelling Shed** to support their spelling and language development.
